Building hundreds of defibrillator stations in street corners, that can be used in case of such an emergency.



These stations can be remotely opened by Health Services and thus people within close proximity to a station can use it to save a man's life while waiting for an ambulance to arrive.



A smart station, remotely operated: On the Control room command, the box will be open, an alarm will be sound and red strobe start to flash. As back up, a mechanical combination lock is available. The control room will be alert if the defibrillator will be out of its position.
